
9 AM Sermon: 6 PM Preview:

The Final Word | 2 Timothy 3:14-17 Deep Dive: Let the Ancient Words Impart

Theme for the Year. Last week. I introduced our theme for 2025: Fundamentals of the Faith. If you weren't able to be here, go back and watch/listen on either Facebook or YouTube. That sermon will give you a good idea of our focus for this new year. Throughout the year, we are digging into our core convictions, the basic beliefs that form the foundation of our Christian faith. Almost all Sunday morning sermons this year will focus on the fundamentals. We will seek to answer (1) What do we believe? and (2) Why do we believe what we believe? We'll talk about the Bible, God, humanity, sin, Israel, Christ, the Holy Spirit, salvation, the church, Christian ethics, angels & demons, last things, and more. Sunday nights will give us an opportunity to take a deeper dive on the topic we're discussing. On certain Sunday nights, we'll have Q & A sessions on particular topics (more details on this coming soon). As I said last week, I'm excited to spend 2025 grounding ourselves in the fundamentals so we can be built up into who we are made to be!

Wednesday Nights. Two new adult classes will continue this Wednesday at 7 PM and through the end of February. Dan Walker is teaching a series called "The Holy Spirit: God's Power in My Life" in the Vanzant Lobby. And I am teaching another in Room 214 called "Ordinary Days, Extraordinary God" about bringing glory to God in our everyday routines. Join us on Wednesdays, and bring your kids and teens!
