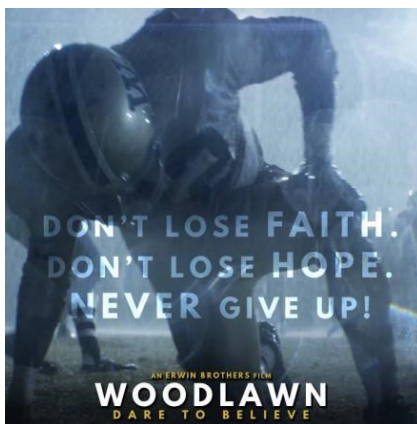

Lou Pfister will be teaching a class called "Life—You'll Get Through This" about staying focused on God through life's many adversities.

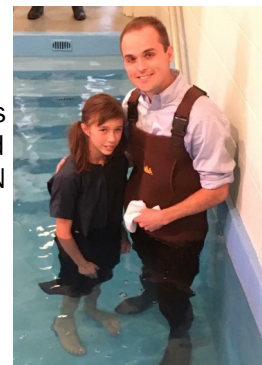
